TEAM WORLD WIDE TECHNOLOGY RACEWAY 2019

Team World Wide Technology Raceway for the 2019 E.T. Finals will be comprised of 32 total vehicles from our World Wide Technology Raceway Championship events (listed above) and 2

High School participants. Only racers who have signed up for points membership and have competed in Carl's 4WD Super Pro, Pro, Sportsman and Super Pro Bike will be eligible for competition at the 2019 Summit E.T. Racing Series NHRA Finals in Indianapolis. Racers will be chosen based on final points standings at the end of the season. The number of racers taken per class will be dependant on the overall participation of the class throughout the season. Kevin Corzine will be the Team Coordinator for 2019. NHRA Division 3 has some exciting programs to change up Indy for 2019, including 3 Races now. We will have full details shortly.

A word from 2019 Indy Team Coordinator:

I have volunteered to be the coordinator for team World Wide Technology Raceway for the 2019 Div 3 ET Finals. Please take some time and read all the information available for the new multi race format they are planning for this year in Indy. Please also read all of the new incentives and plans World Wide Technology Raceway is offering to be in the points program to be eligible for the finals. I will be in points this year and part time working the track so I will be very visible throughout the year and would like anyone interested, joining, or having any questions to stop by and talk with me and let me know your intentions.

NEW FOR 2019 Highlights:

- Re-Vamped Points Structure, now following the NHRA Sportsman Points Standard, see www.wtraceway.com for more info.
- Bye run now determined off Best Reaction Time, unused by carries over until Ladder Round.
- Bonus payout in Super Pro, Pro, and Sportsman for joining the Points Membership and making the final round. See Payouts for more information.
- Increased End of Year Purse!
- Rookie of the Year Program: If you have run 3 or less races in a class per year over the last 5 years, you are eligible for "Rookie of the Year" status for that class. There will be something special at the end of the year. Please select Rookie Eligibility on the Points Signup Form.
- 2nd Time Trial Round will be a "Run for the Money". Cash entry to be paid in the staging lanes, Super Pro and Pro is \$20, Sportsman is \$10. Put a dial in on your car once you

have paid. 50% of the money goes to the winner, 50% of the money goes to the Year End Points Fund per class. You can track the progress of the Year-End fund online on the points page.

- In the event of a tie, tie-breaker policy is as follows:
 - 1st Tie-Breaker: Best Reaction Time
 - 2nd Tie-Breaker: whoever did it first
- 2019 Season Banquet to be held during the AAA Midwest Nationals!!!
- Bracket Racing Call-Outs: Do you have that race you are dying to see? Do you want to put some skin in the game and call out your buddy? Put up some money and we will make the race happen. More details coming soon.

Points Program Overview:

- Drivers competing in multiple classes must have each class listed on their car.
- Drivers entering in multiple classes are solely responsible for quickly returning to the lanes between rounds of competition. All classes will be based on 10 minute turn-around rule.
- All drivers and cars must meet minimum NHRA competition guidelines. Please refer to the 2019 NHRA rulebook.
- Point registration must be purchased before points will be credited. Point Membership registration fee is \$50 per year, per class and includes NHRA –or- track number registration. MUST be signed up for points prior to Round 1 of competition to be eligible for “Points Bonus” Money.
- New for 2019; ALL competitors who compete in a Carl’s 4WD event will have their points tracked, however, to receive points and be eligible for Indy, the \$50 Points Membership MUST be purchased. You will only receive the points for races AFTER you sign up for Points Membership, they will NOT go retro-active.
- Please refer to www.wvtraceway.com and monthly e-mail update for schedule information as they will change based on event schedule/special features.
- Track reserves right to add special bracket eliminators at all events based on show content, time constraints and weather. Our main priority will be for the championship point classes.
- Trophy is established as an entry level class designed to introduce our street legal, Midnight Madness and High School participants to the sport of bracket racing. Drivers with more than 5 consecutive years of bracket racing experience are not eligible to enter. Trophy is a non-points class. If you have won 2 prior races in Trophy, you are no longer eligible.
- World Wide Technology Raceway will utilize Compulink TruSTART for all classes in the 2019 Points Series. A special description of True-Start will be posted in the racer’s tab of www.wvtraceway.com
- All items are subject to change at the discretion of the event director. All decisions by the event director are final.
- In the event of a tie in the final standings, a tie-breaker will be used to determine final finish. Tie-breakers are outlined in the racer handbook posted on www.wvtraceway.com

2019 Season Banquet Details:

Anyone signing up for points by the end of the first weekend (completion of race #2) will get \$100 in bonus perks for free:

- Free admission ticket to the Friday, September 27, 2019 AAA Insurance NHRA Midwest Nationals and 1 free ticket to the awards banquet being held following racing that evening. (\$70 value)
- World Wide Technology Raceway collectible aluminum insulated tumbler (\$30 value) which will be distributed at the May 25 & 26 event.

2019 Dragstrip Awards Banquet – Friday, September 27

- Banquet will be held at World Wide Technology Raceway immediately following the completion of drag racing activities.
- The banquet tent will open at 7 p.m. on Friday night with dinner at 8 p.m. and awards beginning 15 minutes following the completion of racing. Banquet attendees will enjoy the event from the comforts of a corporate finish line area tent. Awards presentation will last approximately 75 minutes.
- Bracket members who sign up prior to April 7 will receive one (1) adult general admission race ticket and a banquet ticket free of charge.

- Bracket members, who did not sign up prior to April 7, will be eligible to purchase a general admission/banquet ticket combo for only \$50. (A \$20 discount). Purchase must be completed by Monday, September 9, 2019.
- Each racer is eligible to purchase up to 4 Friday general admission/banquet combo tickets for \$50. Additional adult race/banquet combo tickets, if available, will be \$70.
- Kids 12 and under banquet tickets will be available to purchase for \$15 (as kids 12 and under are free to the event).
