Competition Classes

The show will be headlined by the heads-up racing action of the **Outlaw (time shown), 1/8th Mile Cash Class (NEW FOR 2019!), Street Car, Street and Stick Shift Shootout**. The heads-up classes will feature no-time on the scoreboards and only a win light will be shown, except for Missouri Outlaw, which will be run in a Quick 8 Format.

Outlaw Shootout: 1/8 Mile Heads Up, any engine, any power adder, any tire, backhalf cars permitted, wheelie bars permitted. Elimination rounds will be a Quick 8 format with alternates permitted. 60 minute turn-around time from the LAST car going down track. Heads Up 1/8 Mile Cash Class: 1/8 Mile Heads Up, current license plate/tag that matches vehicle required, any engine, any power adder, limited tire size, backhalf cars permitted, clocks off. \$100 buy in + \$40 tech card. Street Car Shootout: 1/4 Mile Heads Up, current license plate/tag that matches vehicle required, any engine, any power adder, any tire, no backhalf cars, no tube chassis, clocks off. Callout your opponent in eliminations or test the hat draw. Rule set, overview, racers, fans, parking area, and race results are found here – over 1300 members!

Stick Shift Class: 1/4 Mile Heads Up, any engine, any power adder, no backhalf cars, no tube chassis, H-pattern manual transmission only, any size slick or drag radial, no hard street tires permitted. Callout your opponent in eliminations or test the hat draw. Rule set,

Two Full-Bodied 1/8 Mile Index Classes: Another option for full-bodied, door car racers. 6.0 and 7.0 Index, .400 Pro Tree. That is all the rules to it. Qualified closest to Index, pro ladder. \$500 to win. \$250 to runner-up. Minimum of 9 cars for full payout, semi's paid with more than 12 cars. **Lane choice determined by higher qualified car throughout eliminations.**

Dragster 5.70 1/8th Mile Index Class: Another option for dragsters and altereds. Center Steer ONLY. 5.70 Index (NHRA Super Comp Equivalent) Qualified closest to Index, pro ladder. \$500 to win. \$250 to runner-up. Minimum of 9 cars for full payout, semi's paid with more than 12 cars. **Lane choice determined by higher qualified car throughout eliminations.**

Index Motorcycles: Two motorcycle Index classes. Crazy 8's (8.88) and 9.50. Qualified closest to Index, pro ladder. Payout based on total entries.

Jr. Index Madness: Declare your Index when going through Tech; 7.90, 8.90, 9.90, 10.90, 11.90, 12.90, or 13.90. Classes are contested on a .5 Pro Tree. 6-9 year olds will be run separate from 10+ year olds until there is 1 left, then they will be mixed in with the remaining other cars. (Similar to MidWest Jr. Super Series Pro-Sportsman Class)

Plus – Grudge / Time Only Racing – Settle the score on the track. From 10:30 p.m. – 12 a.m. the track is open for no-time, win light only racing. 3-run punch card provided with entry.

YEAR-END AWARDS

Each class of racing will be contested as an official World Wide Technology Raceway Championship category. No membership is required, but we ask that you fill out a registration form for information purposes. Six races will be contested with a driver's 4 best finishes counting toward the title. (if 7th race is added, series will be best 4 of 7). A driver must compete in at least 50% of the races to be eligible for year-end awards. The Champion in each class will receive a championship jacket.
