The top two in points in Super Pro, Pro, Sportsman and Motorcycle will face off in a three-round runoff to be named King of the Arch and receive a special-edition trophy produced exclusively for this event.

CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES

TEAM WORLD WIDE TECHNOLOGY RACEWAY 2020

Team World Wide Technology Raceway for the 2020 E.T. Finals will be comprised of 32 total vehicles from our World Wide Technology Raceway Championship events (listed above) and 2 High School participants. Per NHRA D3 Rules: Qualified drivers must have participated in a minimum of three (3) track point events and be listed on the track's roster prior to the gates opening for the event. Only racers who have signed up for points membership and have competed in Carl's 4WD Super Pro, Pro, Sportsman and Super Pro Bike will be eligible for competition at the 2020 Summit E.T. Racing Series NHRA Division 3 Finals in Norwalk, OH. **New from NHRA Division 3 this year, Participants are permitted to run the same vehicle in up to two categories during the event. Vehicles cannot be used by more than one participant during the event.**

NEW FOR 2020 Highlights:

- **Contingency Connection is BACK for 2020! We are taking Hindsight is 2020 to a new level for you racers bringing back the ever popular Contingency Connection Program. Winners of Super Pro, Pro, and Sportsman in each race will receive several thousand dollar contingency package for each race win!!! NOTE: must be signed up for points to be eligible for Contingency Package. More info coming soon.**
- Continuing bonus payout in Super Pro, Pro, and Sportsman for joining the Points Membership and making the final round. See Payouts for more information.
- Increased End of Year Purse!
- Increased payouts for Sportsman and Motorcycle Classes.
- 2nd Time Trial Round will be a "Run for the Money". Cash entry to be paid in the staging lanes, Super Pro, Pro, Sportsman and Motorcycle will all compete within their respective classes. Entry fee is \$10 to participate, cash only, paid in staging lanes. Put a dial in on your car once you have paid. 50% of the money goes to the winner, 50% of the money goes to the Year End Points Fund per class. You can track the progress of the Year-End fund online on the points page.
 - In the event of a tie, tie-breaker policy is as follows:
 - 1st Tie-Breaker: Best Reaction Time
 - 2nd Tie-Breaker: whoever did it first
- All points entrants will receive free Friday ticket to the NHRA Midwest Nationals, post race awards BBQ and a free t-shirt along with other benefits.

Points Program Overview:

- Drivers competing in multiple classes must have each class listed on their car.

- Drivers entering in multiple classes are solely responsible for quickly returning to the lanes between rounds of competition. All classes will be based on 10 minute turn-around rule.
- All drivers and cars must meet minimum NHRA competition guidelines. Please refer to the 2020 NHRA rulebook.
- Point registration must be purchased before points will be credited. Point Membership registration fee is \$60 per year, per class and includes NHRA –or- track number registration. MUST be signed up for points prior to Round 1 of competition to be eligible for “Points Bonus” Money and Contingency.
- ALL competitors who compete in a Carl’s 4WD event will have their points tracked, however, to receive points and be eligible for Indy, the \$60 Points Membership MUST be purchased. You will only receive the points for races AFTER you sign up for Points Membership, they will NOT go retro-active.
- Please refer to www.wtraceway.com and monthly e-mail update for schedule information as they will change based on event schedule/special features.
- Track reserves right to add special bracket eliminators at all events based on show content, time constraints and weather. Our main priority will be for the championship point classes.
- Trophy is established as an entry level class designed to introduce our street legal, Midnight Madness and High School participants to the sport of bracket racing. Trophy is a non-points class.
- World Wide Technology Raceway will utilize Compulink TruSTART for all classes in the 2020 Points Series. A special description of True-Start will be posted in the racer’s tab of www.wtraceway.com
- All items are subject to change at the discretion of the event director. All decisions by the event director are final.
- In the event of a tie in the final standings, a tie-breaker will be used to determine final finish. Tie-breakers are outlined in the racer handbook posted on www.wtraceway.com

Checks will be cut and mailed the Tuesday following the event, a valid 2020 W-9 MUST be on file with World Wide Technology Raceway to receive a check for 2020.
