

# **2020 WWT Raceway Bracket Series Motorcycle Rules:**

## **ET Break: (7.50-15.99) – 1/4 mile**

TRUstart will be used. .500 Full Tree.

## **Entry, Payout, & Contingency:**

\$40 entry fee - \$20 buyback

<b>Win</b>	<b>R/U</b>	
\$200	\$100	6 Bike Minimum, will be pro-rated if less than 6 bikes first round.
5 or less:	75% payback split between win and runner up	
13 or more:	\$50 semi-finalist if 13 or more bikes round 1.	

**Due to the impact of the COVID-19, our series will run a modified pro-rated pay system for the first 4 events of the season while we establish the economic impact of the government mandated changes, distancing rules, etc. Upon completion of the 4<sup>th</sup> event we will make the determination as to next steps in order to ensure that the our venue, classes and programs can continue under the previously announced rules, payouts and formats. Year-End Championship Points Fund (less champion) and payout format subject to change after Race 4.**

## **General Regulations (following NHRA Division 3 Guidelines):**

- Computer: Prohibited unless stock vehicle by new bike manufacturer. See general regulations 9:1
- Data recorders: Permitted. See general regulations 9:2 & 9:10.
- Delay boxes: Permitted, All direct wiring must be clearly identifiable to the tech inspector. See general regulations 8:2 for more information.
- Automated shifter: Permitted.
- Throttle Control: Permitted.
- Ignition: Stutter boxes prohibited. Starting line and or "high side" rev limiters permitted.
- 2-steps, rev limiters or any other rpm limiting devices, legal unto themselves but altered or installed so as to function as a down-track rpm controller, prohibited.
- Switches & buttons: All switches and/or buttons must be standard mechanical connection type.
- Infrared laser, retinal scan, fingerprint, light source or any other non-mechanical type switch and/or button prohibited.
- NHRA license: Required if running 9.99 or quicker.
